# THE ACTIVIST-IN-RESIDENCE

## ABOUT

Activist-in-Residence (AIR) programme aims to encourage mutual learning and collaboration between activists, students, and researchers, to enhance public oriented scholarship and community engagement around the consequences of racism and racialisation.

This programme supports our innovation incubator programme. The AIR programme will bring one activist in residence to the FCRJ based at SOAS for a six-month period. During this time, they will be expected to conduct their action-oriented research project aligned with FCRJ's [research priority areas](#) and co-create a summer workshop.

The AIR will be offered a grant of 6,000£ to

1. Produce a piece of research work. This could be a repository/archive of resources on a specific event/issue; hosting an exhibition; creating a short film, completing a scoping study.
2. Co-organise with FCRJ a summer workshop that brings together activists and scholars around the topic of investigation.

## YOU WILL BRING AN INTEREST IN:

1. Action research
2. Working with academic researchers, educators, or students
3. Creating public facing, educational content on issues related to 'race' and racism

## FCRJ WILL

1. Support you to meet and develop creative collaborations who are interested in anti-racism
2. Provide access to SOAS library, archival collections, and a physical working space.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Applicants need not have any prior experience of working with a university.
2. Applicants must be able to work in the UK.
3. Please submit an expression of interest that outlines the project you would work on along with your CV.

## TIMELINE

1. Deadline for submission of applications: December 15th, 2023
2. Residence starts: January 2024
3. Residence ends: 6 months after start date.
